

INVITATION FOR BIDDING

Sealed Bid Proposals for the East Terminal Airborne Pathogen Mitigation at Hector International Airport, Municipal Airport Authority, Fargo, North Dakota, will be received by Shawn A. Dobberstein, AAE, Executive Director, Municipal Airport Authority, until 2:00 pm local time, Tuesday, August 30, 2022.

There will be a Pre-bid walk-through. Meet at the boardroom at the Municipal Airport Authority on Tuesday, August 16, 2022 at 10:00 am.

Bid Proposals must be delivered before the time and date indicated above to the Municipal Airport Authority Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Westside Terminal Building of Hector International Airport, Fargo, North Dakota, where they will be reviewed.

All Bid Proposals shall be in accordance with Bidding Documents prepared by T.L. Stroh Architects, Ltd, 8 Seventh St. N., Fargo, North Dakota.

Bidding Documents may be examined at the following locations until Bid opening time:  
T.L. Stroh Architects, Ltd, Fargo, ND and CMTA Engineers

Each Bid submitted shall consist of two separate sealed envelopes, attached together, with each envelope clearly marked on the outside with the contractors' name, "project title – East Terminal Airborne Pathogen Mitigation", and "bid date – August 30, 2022."

Each Bidder shall submit in one envelope a Bidder's Security Bond in a sum equal to (5%) five percent of the full amount of the Bid to the Municipal Airport Authority, executed by a surety company authorized to do business in North Dakota.

**All Government forms as provided in the specification shall be completed and included in the Bid Form Envelope.** All bonds shall comply with North Dakota Century Code, including Chapter 48-01 as amended.

Each Bidder shall hold a current and valid North Dakota Contractor's License of the proper class issued by the Secretary of State, and shall enclose a copy of the license or certificate of renewal of the license **in the same envelope as the Bidder's Security Bond.** The license shall be for the highest amount of the Bidder's total bid combination including selected alternates.

**Each Bidder shall submit in the second envelope the Bid form and all government forms** as supplied with this Bid Invitation. All bids must be upon the basis of cash payment for the work and materials and must be sealed. Bids that do not follow the bidding requirements will not be opened. **Receipt of addendum must be acknowledged on the bid envelope.**

The Bidder, in compliance with this Invitation for Bids of the Hector East Terminal Airborne Pathogen Mitigation, Fargo, ND, having examined the Plans and Specifications with related Documents and the Site of the Proposed Work and being familiar with all the Conditions and Terms, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials and supplies and to construct the Project in accordance with the Contract documents within the time set forth therein and at the prices stated in the Bid Proposal. These prices are to cover all expenses incurred in the performance of the Work required under the Contract Documents of which the Bid Proposal is a part.

The Bidder agrees that this Bid Proposal shall be good, and may not be withdrawn, for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bid Proposals and to waive informalities therein.
